Leucopaxillus lilacinus

Purple Turnover grows on the ground in eucalypt forests; it probably helps a nearby eucalypt tree to get food from the soil.

It has a dry, shiny **purple cap**, **purple and white stem**, and **cream gills** that turn **rusty-brown** with age.
